

**Directions:** Post code is TN12 5LL. It is near the Paddock Wood Hop Farm and takes about 35 minutes from Pip n Jims. Take A229 towards Maidstone. Join M20 going towards London. Take 2nd exit off M20 to A228 to Tonbridge and Hop Farm via Kings Hill. Two miles after Kings Hill take 2nd exit off roundabout to Tonbridge (A26) and Tunbridge Wells (A228). At next roundabout take 1st exit to East Peckham/Paddock Wood/Hop Farm. At the next roundabout take 3rd exit to East Peckham – see map above. Take 3rd road on the right (Church Lane); at T junction turn right and then right into the village hall car park, after the church.
